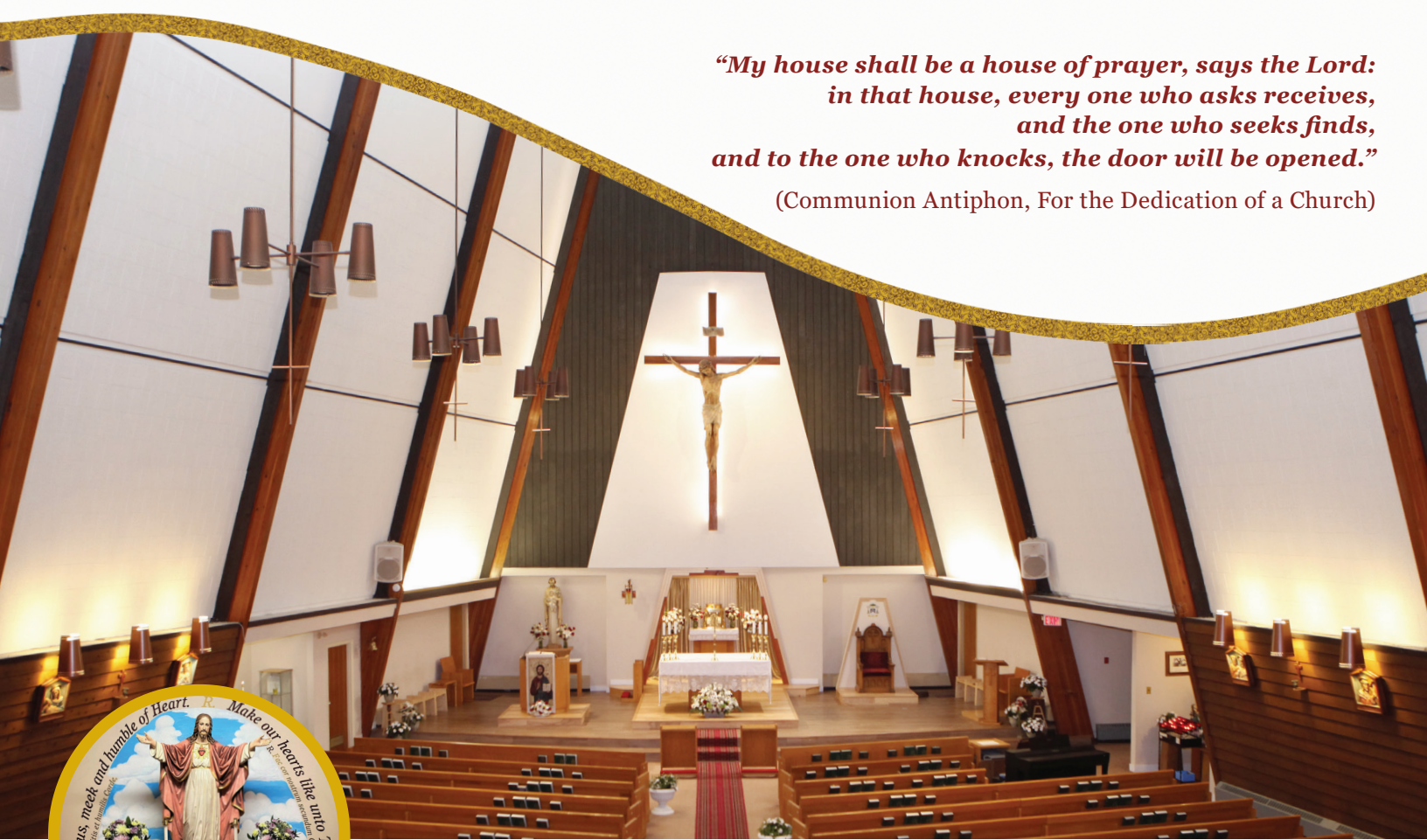

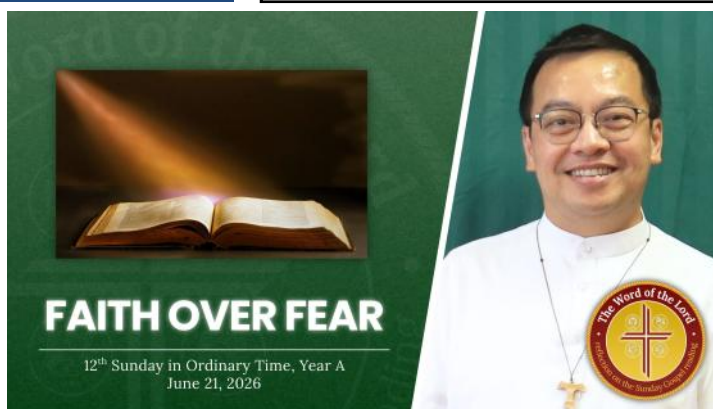


Our final Parish/School Mass took place on Saturday, June 20 at 5:30 p.m. Sincere thanks to all who volunteered for ministries over the school year.

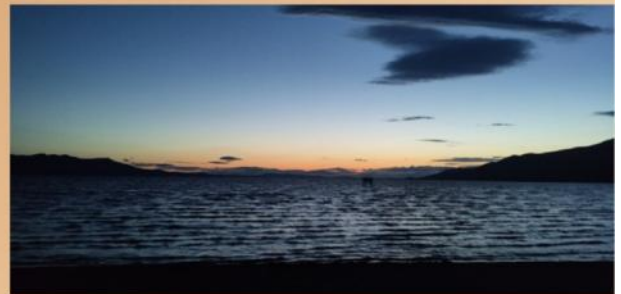

UNVEILING OF THE CATHEDRAL RECTORS' GALLERY

| Sacred Heart Cathedral, Diocese of Prince George

On Friday, June 12, 2026, the Solemnity of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, World Day of Prayer for Sanctification of Priests, our Parish Feast Day, we dedicated a wall in the lower church hall as the Cathedral Rectors' Gallery, a special tribute to the priests who have served the Sacred Heart Cathedral Parish community through-

out its history.

Displayed on a wall is a list of the priests—assistant priests, pastors, and rectors—who have been assigned to this parish over the years. While we were not able to obtain portrait photographs of every priest who served here, the inclusion of their names reflects our sincere desire to honor each one and to recognize the unique journey they shared with the people of this parish.

I would also like to note that the list of names was compiled from the records provided by the Diocesan Archives. If you happen to know of a priest who served here but whose name does not appear on this wall, I ask for your understanding and consideration, as we have relied upon the information available to us at this time.

Father Rector hope that this gallery will become an ongoing tradition in our cathedral parish. Going forward, may the portrait of each outgoing rector be added to this wall during the final Parish Feast Day he celebrates with the community...Explanation of the various elements that make up this Cathedral Rectors' Gallery.

At the top center is a crucifix, similar in style to the Oblate Cross. It was chosen in recognition of the many Oblates of Mary Immaculate who have lived and served in this parish community throughout the years.

Directly beneath the crucifix is the image of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the patron of our cathedral parish. Its place at the center of this display reminds us that Christ and His Sacred Heart remain at the heart of our identity and mission.

Below the image of the Sacred Heart is an illustration of a chalice and sacred host. Positioned at the center of the gallery, it symbolizes the Eucharist, which is the source and summit of our parish life. It also serves as a reminder that the priests whose names appear here faithfully led this community in the celebration of the sacred mysteries entrusted to the Church.

At the bottom center is a quotation from Saint John Mary Vianney, whose image appears in the upper left corner of the gallery. As the patron saint of parish priests, he stands as an enduring example of pastoral charity, humility, and dedication to the people of God.

In the upper right corner is an image of Our Lady at the Annunciation. This image honors Our Lady of the Annunciation, the patroness of our diocese, and reminds us of Mary's faithful "yes" to God's call.

On either side of the gallery, you will find prayers dedicated to priests—one for priests who are living and actively serving the Church, and the other for priests who have gone before us into eternal life. Their inclusion reflects our belief that gratitude for our priests should always be accompanied by prayer. We pray for those who continue to minister among God's people, asking the Lord to strengthen them in holiness, wisdom, and pastoral charity. We also remember with gratitude those priests who have completed their earthly pilgrimage, entrusting them to the mercy of God and praying that they may enjoy the fullness of eternal life in His presence.

Finally, in the lower left and right corners are the familiar emblems of our cathedral parish, which are often used on our printed and digital communications. Their inclusion helps connect this gallery to the ongoing life and ministry of our parish today.

This gallery is more than a collection of names and photographs. It is a visible reminder that our parish has been built, strengthened, and sustained through the faithful service of many priests and the enduring faith of generations of parishioners.

As we look upon this wall, may we remember with gratitude those who came before us, pray for those who continue to serve the Church today, and entrust the future of our cathedral parish to the loving care of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

May this Cathedral Rectors' Gallery inspire us to cherish our history, honor those who have shepherded God's people, and continue building a vibrant parish community rooted in faith, hope, and love for generations to come.
